Staffing Update

Sadly, we are saying goodbye to Mr Gilborson at the end of the summer term. We would like to thank Mr Gilborson for everything he has done and wish him all the best for the future.

We are delighted to inform you that we have appointed two new class teachers, Mrs Ellie Marriott and Mrs Lizzie Chambers. Mrs Chambers will be joining us after half term and will be initially based in Toucans class. Mrs Marriott will join us in September. Both teachers have a wealth of experience in working with children who have special educational needs.

Due to the high number of demands for specialist school places, the Willows will be expanding from 50 to 55. This will take effect from September 2024. The local authority is supporting this change by allocating some additional funding that will enable us to make adjustments to our provision. This includes additional furniture and restructuring of classroom spaces to make them bigger. We will continue to ensure that our class sizes are no bigger than 10.

- help parent carers build confidence in understanding and supporting their child's need
- support parent carers to find a positive way to moving forward
